Course Outline

Health care workers make a real difference to the comfort, care and independence of patients every day.

Enrolled Nurses work under the supervision of a Registered Nurse and duties may include: personal hygiene care for patients, monitoring a patient's vital signs, complex wound dressings, administration of medications, admission and discharge of patients, assisting in theatre, reporting, documentation, assisting the doctor with medical procedures. As a skills shortage area, nursing graduates have excellent employment prospects. Successful completion of an Enrolled Nursing qualification allows you to up-skill by providing one year credit towards a Registered Nurse University qualification, saving time and money.

Career Opportunities

Graduates from Diploma in Nursing will have the potential to obtain employment as an Enrolled Nurse in hospitals, home care facilities and community health care centres.

Minimum completion of Year 12 studies (with high competence in mathematics and science), completion of Certificate IV Health Science Foundations or relevant work experience is required.

A supervised workplacement is required to undertake practical assessments throughout your studies.

A *Federal Police Clearance* and a *Senior First Aid Certificate* are required prior to undertaking the practical components of this course.
